









In 2017 it received its Geographical Indication (GI).


The varied alluvial soils, cool nights and warm sunny days are a winemakers dream.

With a total of 407 Hectares (1005 acres), Finca Los Arbolitos currently has 270 hectares (670 acres) of vines in production.





Tiny Houses




Invest in La Morada Lodge, a project based on the successful Fierro Hotel Buenos Aires, founded and managed by the same Group since 2010.


32 fully equipped units each measuring 40 m2 (431 sq.ft.) plus 24 m2 (260 sq.ft.) of roofed shaded area each with its own hot tub. They are located close to the Hornero Restaurant.



Life Pods

These are houses located close to La Morada Lodge where the owners have access to all the amenities.

Owners may choose to have La Morada Lodge operate their homes to generate rental revenue while they are not being used.

A total of 32 two bedroom homes are planned. Each is 69 m2 (743 sq.ft.), with 28 m2 (300 sq.ft.) of shaded areas, all on an 800 m2 (8600 sq.ft.) lot.





Life Homes

These luxurious, airy 3 bedroom homes are located on 1.250m2 (13,500 sq.ft.) lots. Their large terrace grants privileged views of the Andes, and a private pool cools the summer days.

Up to 44 units will be built, each with a surface of 140 m2 (1500 sq.ft.) and shaded galleries of 57 m2 (615 sq.ft.)





Progress so far...


La Morada Life project was launched in August 2022 and we have been busy...

- We reformed the existing guesthouse, adding a state of the art kitchen, reception area, two wood fired ovens, a 100 M2 / 1100 sq ft temperature controlled wine cellar and fully equipped bar.
- Our new restaurant Hornero opened in January 2023 and is offering lunch and dinner 7 days a week as well as serving up an incredible breakfast to our hotel guests.
- We have completed 8 Tiny Houses, each with their own natural hot tub. These fully furnished units, built around a new swimming pool, are now operational and have been incorporated into the La Morada Lodge. Occupancy has been well above expectation.
- ☐ 6 Life Pods are in the final stages of construction and we expect to hand the keys over to their new owners in October of this year.
- → 2 Life Homes are currently under construction and will be completed in February 2024.
- The innovative children's play area, tennis court and paddle tennis court have all been completed. We are currently in the process of adding shaded picnic areas and an organic vegetable and herb garden.






























Hornero Restaurant is the focal meeting point at La Morada Life - directed by founding partners, Chef Edward Holloway and Sommelier Andrés Rosberg.


It has a cocktail bar and a 100 m2 (1100 sq.ft.) wine cellar with over 10,000 bottles of the finest wines from Valle de Uco and the rest of Argentina. Tastings with the most prestigious wine-makers will be hosted regularly.

The restaurant opened in February to great acclaim.

The concept is designed around 2 bespoke wood fired ovens, with fresh local ingredients roasted to order.


The drinks programme includes a fully stocked bar with classic cocktails.


The wine list, with over 400 labels, is a who's who of the best Argentine wines with an emphasis on Los Chacayes and Uco Valley.


















